OUCH! PLEASE BE EXTRA CAREFUL!

Our drop-off and pick-up times involve many cars moving through a tight area in a short period of time. Please be extra vigilant as you drive through our property.

1. Watch out for our children. They may dart out between cars without warning. Please walk your child across the parking lot areas. Please also walk your child across One Street if you park on the far side.
2. Watch out for other cars. If you are driving through, please watch the cars pulled over to the side. They may pull out without seeing you in their blind spot.
3. Look carefully before you pull out from a parking spot or from the area along the sidewalk. Other cars will be passing you and you may not see them in your blind spot.
4. Drive slowly onto the property, past the modular classrooms, and off of the property.

No matter how big a hurry you are in to get to work or to get home after a busy day, it is never worth taking a risk with the safety of our students and their families. No one wants a fender bender or any other accident!
